## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Town of Taos, New Mexico, wishes to inform all interested parties that a public hearing will be held on Tuesday, December 12, 2017, 2:30pm, at the Council Chamber located in Coronado Hall at 120 Civic Plaza Drive, Taos, New Mexico, 87571. The purpose is to report on past CDBG program activities and to receive public input on community development needs and suggestions for future CDBG projects.

The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program was established under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, in order to assist communities in providing essential community facilities, providing decent housing for residents, promoting economic development and maintaining a suitable living environment.

State and national objectives of the CDBG Program require that assistance be made available to for activities that address at least one of the following:

- 1) an activity identified as principally benefiting persons of low and moderate income;
- 2) aid in the prevention and elimination of slums and blight;
- 3) meet other community development needs of recent origin having a particular urgency because existing conditions pose a serious and immediate threat to the health and welfare of the community where other financial resources are not available to meet such needs.

Applications are limited to a maximum of \$500,000, except for planning applications which have a limit of \$50,000.

Eligible activities and categories will be described. All interested parties are invited to attend, to submit project ideas, to provide supporting data and testimony, and other pertinent information. With sufficient notice, a translator will be provided for non-English speaking residents.
