**KONGOS CONCERT
TRANSIT PICK-UP AND DROP OFF LOCATIONS
FREE PARKING LOCATIONS**

Wednesday, September 24, 2014 – Taos, NM

PUBLIC TRANSIT

The Taos “Chili Line” will pick up and drop off concert goers every 20 minutes at the following locations on Taos’ main commercial corridor, Paseo del Pueblo (Rt. 64) and deliver passengers to the Concert on the Plaza all day, from noon until 7 pm.

The Chili Line will return passengers to all of the same stops from the Plaza after the concert for up to 30 minutes after the concert ends, which is expected to be around 9 pm.

A map showing the stops along the concert route is attached.

- Sagebrush Inn
- Hampton Inn
- Paseo del Pueblo Sur and Roy Road
- Taos Visitors Center (Paseo del Pueblo Sur and Paseo de Canon)
- Quality Inn
- Jack Wrap It Copy center (Opposite WalMart)
- Taos County Complex (Paseo Del Pueblo Sur and Albright Road, opposite Wendy’s at the bus stand in the parking lot) **FREE PARKING**

FREE PARKING

Free parking on a first come first serve basis can be found at the following locations. All locations are within walking distance of the Plaza:

- Taos County Complex (front parking lot at Paseo del Pueblo Sur and Albright St. and the dirt lot on Albright St. behind the Complex and across the street to the south, look for the County vehicles)
- Taos Municipal Complex (400 Camino de la Placita)
- Loretto Parking Lot (Camino de la Placita opposite the Plaza to the west, look for “Free Parking” sign)
- Kit Carson Road Lot (Kit Carson Road and Quesnel, bottom of Kit Carson Road heading east from Plaza)

METERED PUBLIC PARKING

Additional metered public parking can be found throughout the downtown both on main streets and in metered lots, as identified on the attached map. In addition, there are numerous private “pay lots” around the Plaza area.
