Mayor Barrone Proclaims April 25th Arbor Day

April 23, 2014 - Last evening, at the Regular Town Council Meeting, Mayor Daniel Barrone issued a proclamation asking all citizens of Taos to recognize April 25, 2014 as Arbor Day.

He urged all citizens to support efforts to care for our trees and woodlands and support our the Community Forestry Program. Mayor Barrone will celebrate Arbor Day by planting a tree at the Taos Public Library on Friday, April 25, 2014 at 1:30 p.m. Paul Bryan Jones, Chair of the New Mexico Urban Forestry Council, members of Los Jardinos, the Native Plant Society, Lettuce Grow Farms, and Town staff will be present to observe the tree planting and will begin work to restore a native plant garden as well as install a spiral garden for the Children's Library.
