One Week Left of Early Voting for Municipal Election

February 24, 2014 - Voters who wish to vote early for the Municipal Election may do so until this Friday, February 28, 2014 at Town Hall, 400 Camino de la Placita, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. (open during Noon hour).

The Regular Municipal Election will be held on March 4, 2014 at Coronado Hall, 120 Civic Plaza Drive from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. For those who are unable to vote on this date, they may vote early as indicated above. In addition, voting by mail has been ongoing since January 28th and ballots can be mailed out until February 28th; however, the Town Clerk must receive the voted ballot by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, otherwise, the vote cannot be counted.

Renee Lucero, Town Clerk, has clarified only qualified electors of the municipality are eligible to vote in the Municipal Election. Pursuant to NMSA 1978 Chapter 3-8-2, a "qualified elector" means any person whose affidavit of voter registration has been filed by the County Clerk, who is registered to vote in a general election precinct established by the board of county commissioners that is wholly or partly within the municipal boundaries and who is a resident of the municipality. You may contact the Town Clerk's Election Office at (575) 737-2649 to verify if you are on the voter list.
