The Town of Taos is sponsoring a public forum to gather input from the business community on issues and concerns that Town business owners and operators might have, as well as to seek suggestions on what the Town and businesses can do working together to improve the business climate and local economy, both immediately and long-term.

The forum is expected to be the first in a series in which the Town will identify and address administrative, regulatory, infrastructure and other barriers that businesses feel are impeding growth, and that will lead to the formation of a Mayor’s Business and Economic Advisory Council and a long-term business economic strategic plan for the Town and, hopefully, regional and state partners.

All ideas, observations, complaints and concerns will be heard and are welcomed, though due to time and space limitations, the invitation for this first meeting is specifically for those who own or operate a business within the Town limits.

The forum will be held in the Mural Room on the 2nd floor of the Old County Courthouse on the historic Taos Plaza, Monday, June 23rd from 6pm to 9pm.
