BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the property is:


1. of current resale value of \$5000(five thousand dollars) or less;





Re: 2006/2007 Vehicle Replacement

I am asking that units 51, 65 and 92 be removed from the vehicle replacement list that is dated March 10, 2006.

Unit #51 (1992 Ford F-350) will be transferred to the Landfill and will be used as a service truck for the heavy equipment.

Unit #65 (1995 Ford Ranger) will be transferred to the Police Department and will be used as an undercover vehicle.


Unit #92 (1990 K-20 Chevrolet) will be transferred to the Landfill and will be used as a litter patrol vehicle, strictly at the landfill.

Unit #4 (1996 Dodge) currently part of the Fire Department inventory and not on the vehicle replacement list, I am recommending that this unit be transferred over to the Police Department so that it may be used to haul the target board and the 6X utility trailer that the Police Department uses for check points.


