



NOTICE OF ORDINANCE ADOPTION

ORDINANCE NO. 20-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 19-10 DUE TO THE CONTINUATION OF THE COVID-19 HEALTH EMERGENCY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF TAOS:

Section Twelve ("Effective Date") of Ordinance No. 19-10, "An Emergency Interim Development Ordinance Deferring Issuance of Permits for Short-Term Rentals Pending Development of a Comprehensive Regulatory Ordinance," shall be and hereby is amended due to the continuation of the Covid-19 health emergency as declared by the Governor of the State of New Mexico, as follows:

"Section Twelve. Effective Date.

"A. Effective Immediately. [unchanged].

"B. Repeal. This Ordinance is repealed on December 30, 2020; provided that the Governing Body may extent the effective period for additional reasonable periods of time if, in its legislative discretion, such extension is warranted."

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on **Tuesday, May 26, 2020**, the Town of Taos Council, at their Regular Meeting at the Town Council Chambers, Coronado Hall, 120 Civic Plaza Drive, 4:00 P.M., adopted the above referenced ordinance.
