- Laber Repair and replacement parts for the K Turbo blowers which include the following:
1. K Turbo 150hp blower (Membrane aeration system)
  2. K Turbo 200hp blower (Aeration Basin system)
- IV. Provide an explanation of: the criteria developed and specified by the department.
- The K Turbo blowers are an integral part of the treatment process and is the only equipment being used for the aeration of the entire plant. The aeration basin or biological reactor is the heart of any aerobic system. There are requirements that must be met to insure a healthy biological population which thus ensures a good degree of treatment and the completion of the nitrogen cycle. The K Turbo 200hp blowers supply the dissolved oxygen to the active sludge basins. The dissolved oxygen enters each basin through the air diffusers in each basin. The activated sludge then enters the Membrane Filtration building. The membrane basins contain membrane filters that separate the biomass from the wastewater and transfer the clean water to the UV channel as effluent. Air is course bubbled into the membrane

basins to help clean the membranes and prevent them from becoming "blinded" by the mixed liquor solids. The scour air is supplied to the membrane by K Turbo 150 hp blowers. If there is no aeration the process is unable to work due to the automation the system has without the 150hp blowers.

Provide a detailed, sufficient explanation of the reasons, qualifications, proprietary rights or unique capabilities of the prospective contractor that makes the prospective contractor *the one source* capable of providing the required professional service, service, construction or item(s) of tangible personal property. K Turbo is the inventor and owner of the K Turbo blowers. They hold numerous patents and trademarks on these products.

K Turbo is the sole manufacture of the products and exclusive source for part to repair the blowers and other equipment necessary to run them.

K Turbo is the sole manufacture of these products and the exclusive source for service and repairs parts that are under the trademark protection. As the manufacture K Turbo is the only company that is able to perform the work per specifications which would not void any manufacture defect protection.



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

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
